- Meet faculty members from three state universities and learn about admission requirements

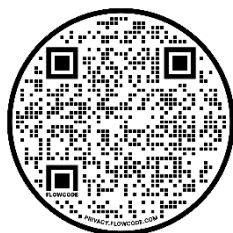
Teachers and Counselors
